**JOB SUMMARY:**

Within the scope of licensing, training, credentialing and privileging the Care Manager is responsible for coordinating and overseeing the provision of integrated medical and behavioral health service delivery for a defined caseload of enrolled/assigned members who are referred to the HCC Health Home program. The Care Manager advocates for and supports members and engages with community agencies/health care providers and others on their behalf to ensure access to services needed to increase wellness self-management and reduce emergency room visits and/or hospitalizations. This position provides support to other HCC providers where applicable by providing consultation, education, and information regarding patients' psychosocial and/or substance abuse conditions, interventions, and other resources to maintain focus on outcomes and best practices.

**MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS AND EXPERIENCE REQUIREMENTS**

1. Bachelor's Degree or Master's Degree in one of the following fields preferred: Social Work; Psychology; Education; Rehabilitation; Occupational Therapy; Counseling; Community Mental Health; Sociology; Speech and Hearing; or Physical or Recreational therapy. Degrees in other related areas may be considered.
  - 1.1. For B.A. level candidates, two (2) years of related human services experience required in providing direct services to people with physical, psychiatric, intellectual, developmental or other disabilities in order to link them to a broad range of services essential to enable them to live successfully in the community.
  - 1.2. For M.A. level candidates, one (1) years of related human services experience required in providing direct services to people with physical, psychiatric, intellectual, developmental or other disabilities in order to link them to a broad range of services essential to enable them to live successfully in the community.
